

# Project update

## Keepit Dam safety upgrade – Phase two

April 2016

Following phase one of the Keepit Dam safety upgrade, phase two involves work on the dam wall to comply with contemporary standards for extreme floods and earthquakes.

### Dam wall strengthening

- **What's involved:** Post-tensioning the concrete section of the dam wall.
- **Progress to date:**
  - Preliminary electrical relocation works completed 2014
  - Expression of Interest (EOI) process with potential tenderers completed
  - Tenders let to select group following EOI process (March 2016)
- **What's coming up:**
  - Award construction contract – estimated mid-2016
  - Site establishment – Spring 2016
  - Commence construction on post-tensioning – Spring 2016



### Other news

- **Storage level:** The water level of the dam will not be affected by the construction works
- **Site access:** Once the site becomes a construction zone, access to the dam wall will be restricted for safety purposes.
- **Community liaison group:** Following the completion of phase one construction we have aimed to keep key project stakeholders up-to-date via emailed bulletins.
