

# Supplementary notice

## SUPPLEMENTARY WATER ACCESS FOR NSW MURRAY VALLEY

21 December 2017

Crown Lands and Water has announced today that a period of supplementary water access would be announced to NSW irrigators in the Murray Valley.

Supplementary access is being made available on the River Murray downstream of the Murrumbidgee Junction due to higher flow in the River Murray and capacity constraints at Lake Victoria.

Customers holding a supplementary water licence, within the reaches where supplementary water is available, have access to the supplementary flows. As available water for general security access licences is currently less than 60%, all general security access licence holders, within the reaches where supplementary water is available, may divert water during this period of supplementary flow as uncontrolled flow (UCF) in accordance with Water Sharing Plan (WSP) rules.

Customers wishing to access supplementary water must place a complying water order using one of the following options:

At the completion of pumping supplementary water, the finish meter reading must be notified to WaterNSW using one of the above four options. Failure to supply the finish reading will result in any water extracted during the event being debited to general security accounts.

Further advice will be issued on or before Wednesday, 27 December 2017.
