December 2023 update



Lake Cargelligo embankment upgrade

The upgrades will improve dam safety and enable the embankments to meet current and future needs of the local community and WaterNSW customers.

Progress update

Over the past few months, we have continued to concentrate our construction work fronts on embankments C2 and C3 as well as the installation of a coffer dam to prepare for start of works at embankment B.

This work has included:

- Stripping and preparing the new embankments with stablised material and new drainage pipework and fittings
- Rebuilding and widening the embankments with conditioned materials
- · Tree removal along embankments
- Installing large rip rap (large rocks) to the lake side of the embankment for further erosion control and protection
- Progressing permits to progress construction on further sensitive areas of embankments B and C
- Completing quality testing across each work area.

Work will resume in January 2024, with an expected completion date for all works by mid to late 2024, weather permitting.

Upcoming work planned in 2024

Upcoming work will include:

- Ongoing vegetation removal
- Installation of filter trenches across all embankments
- Continuation of clay and stablising material for embankment widening
- Upgrade of existing lake outlets including trenching across Nilssons Lane to provide irrigation to landholders
- · Bore drilling and trench digging
- Completing quality testing across each work area
- Demobilisation of all temporary compounds and restoration of all impacted areas

Lake storage capacity

The Lake Cargelligo storage capacity is limited to 75% storage capacity in the short term so WaterNSW can maximise the work completed before the 2024 irrigation season.

This change will not impact recreational users, who will continue to keep the community and our customers updated on any change

Work program

- Continue works at embankments B, C2, and C3
- Prepare work sites for holiday shut down

• Completion of works at embankment C2

• Restoration of completed work areas

 Completion of works at embankments A, C1, C3 and B

- Demobilisation of site compounds and Restoration of completed work areas
- This may include a second drawdown pending lake levels.
