

Keepit Dam Safety Upgrade

CCLG Bulletin

Project Update

SRG Limited has been awarded the 24.4 million contract for the second stage of the NSW Government's Keepit Dam safety upgrade.

The second stage of the upgrade also includes finalising works that were carried out in 2014-15 to relocate electrical equipment from the dam wall, as well as the construction of a switch room for improved access. (The initial phase of this work won a 2015 National Electrical and Contracting Association award).

SRG Limited is a global complex services company with a long history of successfully delivering dam strengthening projects.



- The work to strengthen the main dam wall will involve installing post-tensioned cable anchors.
- Construction is scheduled to commence early in 2017 and is expected to take two and a half years.
- The Keepit works are part of WaterNSW's dam safety upgrade program which is bringing the dams into line with the most stringent contemporary standards.
- The post-tensioning works follow stage one works completed in 2012 which involved construction of two spillways and three saddle dams.

Dam Operations

Access to the dam wall will be restricted for safety purposes during construction.

The Lake Keepit Recreation Park will remain open throughout the construction works.

The water level of the dam and normal water releases will not be affected by the works.

The dam is safe for day-to-day operations and can safely pass the largest flood on record.

The Keepit Dam upgrade Community Consultative Liaison Group (CCLG) was established at the start of construction and met regularly throughout construction to discuss any issues and continue to receive updates on the project.
