


When you are visiting some of our dams, you might be lucky enough to see a sheep along the way!

 Open the pocket at the large arrow, pull forward and flatten. 	 Fold the top corner down along the dashed line. Fold the lower corner behind. 	Fold over the dashed line and add detail to your sheep.
