

End of season checklist

This checklist will provide you with helpful tips for managing your water account and making the most of your water allocation as one season ends and another begins.

Your water account

- Know what your account limit and balance will be on 1 July every year. Ensure you don't have a negative balance
- Register for iWAS, our water accounting system. This allows you to enter and amend your own water orders and meter readings; access all licences and works approvals; download water account statements detailing transactions and account balances; view and download the allocation assignment register; and access current information
- Take action early to transfer unused water. Make sure you have placed any 71T (temporary transfers) before cut off dates.

These dates are available on our website.

- Get trades for supplementary access organised, as some events are likely to be short and you may not have enough time to conduct trades during events.

Your water sharing plan

- Be aware of your carry over limits, Available Water Determinations (AWDs), dam spill and general rules for your valley
- Check your water lead times, as they may have been changed.

Your property

- Check your water meters and organise a service or repair during non-pumping season
- Please notify us if you service or repair your meters
- Deal with any safety issues relating to access

to meter and pump sites so that our Customer Field Officers can safely enter the site.
