SUPPLEMENTARY WATER ACCESS FOR MURRAY

26 June 2020

Department of Primary Industries and Environment - Water has issued an announcement of access to supplementary water for the Murray River systems. Recent rainfall has led to elevated tributary inflows to the River Murray. Lake Victoria is now guaranteed to fill, even under a conservative recession to minimum inflows.

As a result, supplementary access is now available on the River Murray downstream of Hume Reservoir and on the Edward System during the dates listed please refer to page 2 for supplementary access details and dates.

In addition, all regulated river (general security) access licence holders may take water during this period of supplementary flows, if the uncontrolled flow (UCF) limits of their accounts permit. Licence holders are reminded that all diversions count towards the annual usage limit of 100% of entitlement (excludes trades into accounts).

Customers wishing to access supplementary water / uncontrolled flow must place a complying water order using one of the following options:

Customers are reminded that with the conclusion of supplementary access, regulated flow conditions would resume and water orders must be placed in accordance with their licence conditions.

WaterNSW will continue to monitor the situation closely and further advice will be issued if required, on or before Tuesday 30 June 2020.
