

Warragamba Dam Excursion

Terms and Conditions



Duty of Care

Attending teachers exercise duty of care throughout the duration of the excursion with helpers assisting in supervision of students.

Teachers must bring a first aid kit. It should be easy to carry.



Student Numbers and Ratios

To comply with WaterNSW safety requirements, we require that the following minimum adult to student ratios be met with a combination of your school staff and helpers.

Primary 1 adult to 10 students

Secondary 1 adult to 15 students

You are not permitted to bring more students than stated on your confirmation booking form without prior notification.



What to wear and bring

All participants are required to wear flat, enclosed shoes. Open shoes such as sandals or thongs are not suitable footwear.

Participants should wear long sleeves and long pants, as components of the excursion may occur outdoors with very little shade.

A water bottle, hat and sunscreen are also recommended.



Safety

All teachers and helpers are expected to read the **WaterNSW Risk Management Assessment** including **Covid-19 Safety Plan** prior to arriving.

A site safety induction will be delivered prior to the excursion commencing.

Warragamba Dam is an operational dam site; therefore, we may need to amend or cancel components of the excursion.

We will contact you at the earliest opportunity should cancellation be necessary.

WaterNSW may record images of students and of supervising adults during school excursions to WaterNSW operational sites.

These images may take the form of photographs and/or videos for internal and external use by WaterNSW across various types of media to educate schools and the general public about WaterNSW.
