- a. all water taken and used pursuant to my basic landholder rights water supply works approval will only be used for domestic consumption or, stock watering
- b. domestic consumption and stock watering are defined in the *Water Management Act 2000* (NSW) as;
 - domestic consumption**, in relation to land, means consumption for normal household purposes in domestic premises situated on the land.
 - stock watering**, in relation to land, means the watering of stock animals being raised on the land, but does not include the use of water in connection with the raising of stock animals on an intensive commercial basis that are housed or kept in feedlots or buildings for all (or a substantial part) of the period during which the stock animals are being raised.

It is an offence, under section 344 of the *Water Management Act 2000*, to make a statement that you know to be false or misleading in, or in connection with, this application. A Corporation found guilty of an offence against section 344 is liable to a penalty of \$2.002 million. An individual found guilty of an offence against section 344 is liable to a penalty not exceeding \$500,500. An approval may be suspended or cancelled under the *Water Management Act 2000* in certain circumstances. These include if the holder of the approval is convicted of an offence under that Act.
