

Warragamba Dam Excursion

Frequently Asked Questions



Can we bring parent helpers?

Yes. Attending teachers exercise duty of care throughout the duration of the excursion with helpers assisting in supervision of students.

To comply with WaterNSW safety requirements, we require that the following minimum adult to student ratios be met with a combination of your school staff and helpers.

Primary School 1 adult to 10 students

Secondary School 1 adult to 15 students



What are the costs associated with the excursion?

There is no charge for an excursion to Warragamba Dam.

Entry to our grounds and parking are also free.



What time will the excursion start and finish?

A standard excursion will begin at 10:00am and conclude at 1:00pm.



What facilities are available?

Our expansive grounds have a number of picnic shelters and toilets available. At the conclusion of your excursion, feel free to enjoy your lunch in our grounds.



Will worksheets be provided?

Yes. We will provide your students with worksheets on the day.

We recommend that high school students bring a clipboard and pen.



Do we need to have our bus available for the entire day?

Yes. Please make sure the bus is available all day.

The bus bay is located on the left when approaching the Visitor Centre.

If your excursion includes a guided tour component, the bus will be required to transport students to the dam.



Can we buy food and drink onsite at Warragamba Dam?

No. All visitors will need to bring their own food and drink as there is no kiosk within the Warragamba Dam precinct.

Drinking water is available from a number of bubblers and bottle refill points.
