

Frequently Asked Questions



What are the costs associated with the excursion?

There is no charge for an excursion to Warragamba Dam.

Entry to our grounds and parking are also free.



Do we need to have our bus available for the entire day?

Yes. When booking your bus, please make sure that it is available all day, as it will be used to transport students from the Visitor Centre to the dam for the guided tour component of your excursion.



Can we bring parent helpers?

Yes. You may need to bring parent helpers to comply with our 1 supervising adult to 15 students safety requirement. This is in addition to WaterNSW educators.



Will students be provided with a worksheet on the day?

Yes, we will provide your students with worksheets on the day. We recommend that high school students bring a clipboard and pen.



Can we buy food and drink at the site?

No. All visitors will need to bring their own food and drink as there is no kiosk within the Warragamba Dam precinct.

Drinking water is available from a number of bubblers and bottle refill points around the grounds.



What facilities are available on site?

Our expansive grounds have a number of picnic shelters and toilets available.

At the conclusion of your excursion please feel free to enjoy your lunch in our grounds and use the toilet facilities.



What time will the excursion start and finish?

A standard excursion will begin at 10:00 am and conclude around 1:00 pm. Please refer to the specific excursion information on our website to confirm the times for your excursion.

When you arrive, please come to the Visitor Centre and introduce yourself so that we can take all of the adults through a safety briefing. If you arrive before the excursion starting time, you and your students are free to have a toilet break and some morning tea before we start your excursion.
