

Operations update

Critical drought measures for the Namoi

WaterNSW wishes to advise our Customers of some changes to the drought measures announced earlier this month. The water delivery transmission losses have stabilised, and recent rainfall has provided small but significant relief.

As a result, the 15% restrictions placed on the Upper Namoi and the Lower Namoi licences have now been removed. The restrictions still in place however include:

- General Security water orders for the Lower Namoi will not be accepted after 5 November 2018. Until there are further improvements in conditions, any orders received after 5 November 2018 are unable to be delivered.
- Restrictions on trade.
- As previously advised, the delivery of general security water will be made only to the Namoi River upstream of Gunidgera weir, and to the Pian Creek upstream of Greylands weir.

We will continue to monitor water resources and weather conditions and adjust planned delivery patterns in response to changes in conditions as required.

We recognise the hardship that these measures have placed on customers and we thank you for your understanding and cooperation.
