Lower Lachlan 2020-21 Usage Plan Survey

As of the 15th September Lake Brewster is currently at 60% of capacity, Lake Cargelligo currently holding 77%. If the forecast demand exceeds the current supply, water will need to be transferred from Wyangala Dam. In order for the water order lead time to remain linked to travel time below Lake Brewster, WaterNSW require details of planned usage to forecast monthly demand.
