Latest updates to the DQP Portal

Renamed installation types

Two installation types have been renamed to allow DQP's to identify that they will be installing a meter only (no LID). The 'No LIID' options are selected for sites that either:


- Do not require a LID as the linked entitlement is less than 100ML;
- Have a telemetry exemption due to the site being in a mobile coverage 'black spot'; or
- A meter is being installed ahead of the NSW Department of Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water (DCCEE) paying for a LID to be installed.

Installation Type drop down changes

"New Meter – New LID" has been renamed "New Meter – New LID / New Meter – No LID".

"Replacement Meter – New or Reconfigured LID" has been renamed "Replacement Meter – New or Reconfigured LID / Replacement Meter – No LID".

New meter details – Does the site qualify for an exemption?

When selecting New or Replacement Meter, the section for the new meter details now has additional questions to answered: Does the site qualify for an exemption?

- If a LID is being installed, select 'No'
 - If a LID is NOT being installed, select 'Yes' and confirm the reason why
- If this option is selected, all references to a LID are hidden in the meter compliance process form. The reasons a LID is not being installed are:
- Site does not require a LID as the linked entitlement is less than 100ML;
 - Site qualifies for a telemetry exemption due to the site being in a mobile coverage 'black spot'; or
 - A meter is being installed ahead of the DCCEEW paying for a LID to be installed.
