

CHATTERBOX - HOW TO GUIDE



Folding

Fold diagonally

- Fold the square diagonally in half to form a triangle.
- Open it. Fold it diagonally the other way.
- Open it. You should have two diagonal creases that cross in the center.



Fold the corners to the centre

- Place it print-side down.
- Take each corner and fold it toward the center point (where the diagonal creases meet).
- You should have a smaller square.



Flip and repeat

- Flip it over (the folded flaps face down).
- Take each corner and fold it toward the center point (where the diagonal creases meet).
- You should have an even smaller square.




Fold in half

- Fold it in half.
- You have a small rectangle.



Form the pockets & shape it for use

- Slide your thumbs and index fingers into the four open flaps (pockets) on the underside.
- Pinch the sides together to form a 3D shape.
- Move the flaps back and forth by pinching and pulling with your fingers.



Playing (2 players)

1. Ask your friend to pick one of the outer words (eg. Warragamba).
2. Open and close in alternating directions for each letter of that word.
3. Ask your friend to choose an inner word (eg. rivers)
4. Open and close in alternating directions for each letter of that word.
5. Ask your friend to choose another inner word. Open the flap and ask them the question (eg. Q: "Which is Sydney's largest dam?"). Check the answer to see if they are correct.
