# Lake Cargelligo embankment upgrade

The Lake Cargelligo embankment upgrade project will ensure the new structures comply with modern engineering standards and continue to work effectively for the local community and customers long into the future.

The Lake Cargelligo storage capacity is limited to 75% storage capacity in the short term so WaterNSW can maximise the work completed before the next irrigation season.

WaterNSW will keep the community and customers updated on any change to the lake's storage capacity and will continue to provide fortnightly updates of the project, including the lake's storage capacity, in The Lake News.
