

Theresa Park Weir access road

June 2026

Project update

Repairs are well underway on the access track at Theresa Park Weir, following damage caused by multiple flood events. The work will provide safe and reliable access for WaterNSW staff so we can continue to support essential operations and maintenance activities.

The turning area near the fishway has now been completed, and work is continuing along the access track back from the fishway. Once finished, the upgraded track will be stronger and more resilient to future flooding and heavy rain events.

What's next

Over the next three months, we will:

- Continue to work on the road surface, including concrete and asphalt sections, and build a concrete causeway at a creek crossing.
- Stabilise sections of rock face beside the track by securing loose rocks, installing rock bolts where needed and adding rock fall barriers.
- Strengthen a landslip area by reinforcing the ground with soil nails, building a retaining wall and protecting exposed rock from erosion.

Timing

Construction started in October 2025 and is expected to be completed in **August 2026**, weather permitting.

WaterNSW will continue to work closely with impacted stakeholders and residents and provide updates as the project progresses.
