## Navigation and Search Options

### Search Button Enhancement:

### LID Name Details Update:

LID names have been updated to offer more comprehensive information, especially regarding LID to Meter options (64Bit for Siemens Meters). This update provides greater clarity in your selections.

### Audit Trail for DQPs:

DQPs now have access to an audit trail option within forms. This feature enables DQPs to track changes and maintain a transparent record of activities.

## Additional Fields in Commissioning/Validation Forms:

The Site Commissioning Date and Meter Read fields have been added to Commissioning/Validation forms. These additions aim to assist WaterNSW CDO Team in the QA process by providing more detailed information and provides an accurate meter read offset for water accounting requirements.

## Final Meter Reading Location Update:

The final meter reading for replaced meters has been relocated to the Commissioning/Validation form. This change centralizes information, making it more convenient for you during meter replacement scenarios.
